#### What's so different?

- Traditional professional development workshops are very useful to learn, to share and to compare experience.
- The idea of a workbench rather than a workshop is that along with the learning, participants may construct something to apply in real life.
- •When you build the thing that leverages what you learn, it becomes easier to remember the learning while taking away something of practical value.



### Why would a participant want this?

- \* Offers knowledge from a core leadership knowledge framework while supplementing an alternative but complimentary knowledge body of work for additional value.
- \* Access to two industry professionals who may offer coaching as well as insights of their own, not found in traditional literature.
- \* Ability to set a goal to create something to take away and use in real life. It will be actionable and valuable, even if at a basic level, that may be built upon.



### Workbench Style


- Facilitators broker the discussion that focuses on professional body of knowledge works.
- Adult peer learning through conversations and discussions deepen the focus on content.
- Facilitators help participants to come up with actionable output goals.
- Facilitators portion off time boxes for participants to build or re-tune their actionable take-away.
- Facilitators move from person to person and offer advice, answer questions on how their actionable output is taking shape.




### Structure of Workbench
